- Picture ID
- W-2 form(s) and/ or 1099(s). If you have discarded your 1099, the IRS will accept an estimate of Social Security benefits received in 2009.
- Voided check or savings account information for direct deposit of any refund
- Social Security Card or Individual Taxpayer Identification Number (ITIN), Social Security Card for spouse if filing jointly, and Social Security Cards for dependents if applicable
- Employer Identification Number (EIN) or Social Security Number (SSN) of all childcare providers for child care tax credit
- Proof of home mortgage interest, taxes, etc. if applicable
- Totals for medical expenses, contributions, etc. It is important you add up all your receipts prior to visiting any of the tax assistance locations.
