# **About Our Services**

**Help Line** is the Senior Services program that publishes the annual *Directory of Services for Older Adults in Forsyth County*, but it is just one of the agency's programs that help Forsyth County's seniors age at home. Learn more about our services below:

**HELP LINE** is an information and referral service that provides community resource information to older adults residing in Forsyth County and their families. Resource information and materials describing topics on aging and current county and regional services for seniors are available. Call **336-724-2040** to speak with an Aging Resources specialist.

The Elizabeth and Tab Williams Adult Day Center is an adult day center that provides supervision and care for older adults who cannot be left alone during the day or for people living with frailty or dementia. The center operates Monday through Friday, serves nutritious lunches and snacks, and provides scheduled activities and special projects in a supervised setting. Personal care services are available, and there is a registered nurse on staff to administer medications. Call the Williams Center at 336-724-2155.

**Meals-on-Wheels** provides a hot, nutritious meal each weekday, Monday through Friday, to older adults who have difficulty preparing meals themselves. Volunteers deliver the meals to the recipients of this service. They also bring a cheerful smile to those they serve and provide an important safety check. Call **336-725-0907** for more information.

**Living-at-Home** approves and manages the Community Alternatives Program for Disabled Adults (CAP-DA) for certain Medicaid-eligible individuals in Forsyth County who would otherwise qualify for nursing home placement through its case-management team of nurses and social workers. Case managers assess the needs of eligible applicants and set up and monitor a variety of home care services once they are accepted into the program—helping them remain safely at home for as long as possible. Call **336-725-0907** and ask for the Living-at-Home Administrative Coordinator.

**Home Care** provides Certified Nursing Aides, who under the supervision of a registered nurse, deliver personal care and respite services to older adults in their homes. These services include primary assistance with personal hygiene and secondary help with light housekeeping, simple meal preparation, and pertinent errands. Caregivers are supported by home visits and on-call telephone assistance. Call **336-725-0907** and ask to speak to the Care and Intake Coordinator.

**Senior Lunch** operates four sites located throughout Forsyth County. Participants must be 60 years of age or older and reside in Forsyth County. People attending the Senior Lunch program receive a hot, nutritious meal and participate in exciting activities and/or programing during each session. Call **336-725-0907** for more information.

**Creative Connections/Memory Connections** invites older adults to experience the joy, fulfillment, and connection to others that comes from engaging in the arts. Collaborations with nonprofit partners and professional artists make Creative Connections accessible to adults age 60+ in Forsyth County. The federally funded Memory Connections is a collaborative project designed to enhance the lives of people living with dementia and their caregivers and is provided through the Creative Connections program. Call **336-725-0907** and ask for the Creative Connections Director.
